It was compiled through the diligent efforts of several people, most notably Assistant Athletic Director Robin Goddard, Msgr. Stanley Milewski, Chancellor-Emeritus of the Orchard Lake Schools, and Vice-Headmaster Leonard Karschnia.

The information in this history is set forth in as brief a fashion as possible. To illustrate this, review the entries under 1977 Reading left to right, the following information is given on the first line under the coach and captains data: (1) Date (Sept. 9); (2) Result (W-OLSM win); (3) OLSM's opponent (Detroit Country Day); (4) Game score, with OLSM's point total given first (30-12); An indication of where the game was played (N, H or A).

Other information might be noted on the line concerning the game: (L) league game, (GAC) Gridiron Award Classic, (HC) homecoming, (n) night game, (r) rain (s) snow.

The line beneath the final season game record presents the regular season record, league record, and league finish, in that order. Next comes the points scored and the points given up.

Beneath this is OLSM's state playoff results, followed by OLSM's final overall record, and OLSM's overall points scored and given up.

Other symbols: N1, H1, A1, etc. indicate games played in at neutral site, a home game at a location other than at OLSM, an away game at a location other than at the opponent's, (*, **, †) indicates a special exhibition or playoff game. Championships are noted in **bold**.
